CONCEPT NOTE

Purpose

Engage Heads of State or Government, Ministers and relevant stakeholders to accelerate momentum for the implementation of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (KMGBF) through national statements, and to support negotiations on key issues of the COP and participate in high-level events and multi stakeholder discussions.

Date and Venue

29-30 October 2024, Centro de Eventos Valle del Pacífico (same location as COP 16)

Ministers are invited to stay an additional 2 days (31 October and 1 November) to assist with the final negotiations of COP 16.

Theme of the High-Level Segment

The overall theme of the Conference of the Parties and the High-Level Segment (HLS) is *Paz con la Naturaleza – Peace with Nature*. Within this broad theme, the HLS will encompass the launch of Colombia's Initiative, "World Coalition for Peace with Nature: A Call for Life", and discussions on a selection of topics (described below) aimed to strengthen and support implementation of the Global Biodiversity Framework.

The "World Coalition for Peace with Nature: A Call for Life" is a call to action to address environmental challenges and encourage further strengthening strategies and policies to preserve the planet and its biodiversity. Joining the Coalition is voluntary, it does not constitute a joint negotiation group, nor does it entail legally binding obligations.

The Coalition will invite governments, organizations, environmental leaders, communities and peoples to reinforce international efforts towards greater sustainability and the protection and preservation of nature. It will recognize the crosscutting approach of peace with nature for the sustainability of the planet, promote awareness and strengthen efforts at the local, national, regional and global levels in matters of human rights, peace among peoples, sustainability and socio-environmental justice, bioculturality and international cooperation. These efforts are pillars that require collaboration and permanent action.

The four main topics for the discussions during the HLS will be:

<u>Implementation of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework</u>: The international community will shift from agreement to action at COP 16. Discussions under this topic will be an important opportunity to demonstrate progress in alignment and rapid implementation of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework.





<u>Financing</u>: Resource mobilization from all sources, and re-alignment of all financial flows with the goals of the KMGBF will be key for the successful implementation of the Framework. For discussions under this topic, the participation of Ministers of Finance, as well as Ministers of Environment, is welcome.

<u>Biodiversity and Climate Change</u>: Addressing climate change and biodiversity loss are inseparable challenges. Discussions under this topic will focus on linking the political agendas of climate and biodiversity from CBD COP 16 to UNFCCC COP 29 and COP 30.

<u>Peace with Nature</u>: Drawing upon the overall theme of COP 16 and recalling the appeal made by the Secretary-General of the United Nations to end humanity's war on nature, the discussions around this topic will underline that sustainable development can only be truly achieved with peace among people, peace between people and nature, and respect for human rights.

Format and timetable

Is it envisaged that the HLS would consist of:

- a.) Formal plenary sessions including an opening and closing segment.
- b.) Launch of Colombia's Initiative "World Coalition for Peace with Nature: A Call for Life" in the opening plenary.
- c.) Plenary sessions for national statements with parallel ministerial dialogues on the four thematic issues
- d.) Breakfast, lunch and reception events offered by the Host Government and by partner organizations.

In addition to the above, Ministers are welcome to attend and participate in other high-level side-events taking place in the blue zone.

Output

• A report of the COP President drawing on the outcomes of the four thematic discussions and national statements.

Participants

The number of delegates to the High-Level Segment is expected to be 400-500, including Heads of State or Government, ministerial representatives (Minister or Head of delegation) from Parties and relevant stakeholders, UN Principals, and high-level representatives from the major stakeholder groups of the Convention.
